



'FOREST HIGH ROPES COURSES'

Ropes Course Rules

1. By purchasing a ticket, visitors accept the rules of the Park for all activities.
2. The ropes courses can be used by visitors at their own risk which must be confirmed by signing the liability waiver form when entering the Park.
3. Entering the area of the ropes courses without permission is prohibited.
4. By purchasing climb tickets, visitors can use the following ropes course services: use of equipment, putting on and off gears by the animators, safety gears and training on their individual use and if necessary, help of the animators and rescue.

Climbing on the ropes courses without wearing safety gears is prohibited!

Any damage caused by the improper use of the equipment or by its lost shall be paid by the user of the equipment!

5. Only (individual) gears, such as harness, straps, helmet, lanyards, carabiners, pulley provided by Romai Adventure Park can be used in the Park. The value of any lost or damaged (misused) gears must be paid.
6. Height restrictions of the ropes courses:
 - **children course: minimum height 100cm, maximum height 145cm;**
 - **junior course: minimum height 120cm;**
 - **adult courses: minimum height 145cm.**
7. All visitors, regardless of age and skill level, must be trained in a compulsory training on using the safety gears properly. After being trained on the 'TRAINING' ropes course, visitors can use the ropes courses at their own risk.
8. The trainers decide whether a visitor is capable to use the ropes courses after the assessment of the visitor's skills on the training ropes course. We reserve the right of refusing incapable visitors to use the ropes courses for safety reasons. (In this case, the ticket will be refunded.)

9. Following the safety rules below is compulsory:

Before using the ropes courses, clothes must be adjusted (so that they will not be too loose or dangling), long hair must be tied up and jewellerys (rings, bracelets, necklaces, big earrings, watch) must be removed. **Wearing a ring is particularly dangerous!**

Objects (e.g., mobile phone, keys) can be kept only in enclosed pockets in clothing. The gears must be checked by the animators before use.

- exchanging gears or lending them to each other is prohibited.

- visitors are liable for strict adherence to safety rules and for being continuously connected to safety wire ropes. **For your continuous safety, carabiners must be connected to the safety wire rope (yellow signs at the zip lines and green sign at other obstacles)!** For your own safety please check continuously the condition of the equipment and the safety gears.



Staying on the ropes courses without using safety gears is prohibited and life threatening!

- the pulley can only be placed on the zip line wire rope once the visitor before you has arrived, stopped and unconnected him or herself from the zip line. The same applies when passing below the zip line.

Zippering can only be started once you have checked and made sure that nobody is on the zip line. It is prohibited to start zippering with a jump!

You can only hold on to the straps of the harness or the case of the pulley while zippering! **It is prohibited to grab the wire rope in front of or behind the pulley. You must hold on to the orange ropes (straps)!**

When the pulley is not in use because it is not necessary to the obstacle, it must be connected to the harness with its carabiner. Using the pulley outside the zip lines is prohibited!

- jumping into the safety gears and climbing higher than the fixing point of the safety rope is prohibited. The safety carabiner can never be below shoulder level!

- at the same time, a maximum of 1 person can stay on an obstacle and a maximum of 3 persons can stay on a platform. Safety distance must always be kept.

- the courses have multiple routes, the direction of climbing is optional.

- jumping off the course is prohibited!

- should you have any problem (feeling scared, sick, tired or having an injury), please call the staff and they will safely bring you down.

10. Other rules:

All users shall declare that they are not under the influence of alcohol, medications or drugs, (and they are not having hangover), which is dangerous and may weaken their concentration. Only sober and responsible persons may use the games.

- throwing stones, littering and causing damage to nature are prohibited.
Please do not shout or be too loud!

The operators can stop the operation of the Adventure Park (or one of its course) if they notice any dangerous situation.

In the event of rainy, windy or stormy weather, the obstacle course and the Park can be closed for safety reasons.

Breaking the safety rules or not behaving properly will result in the expulsion of the visitor!
